## Real Estate Discussions and Studies Continue

Spring is in the air, and the Mark Twain Transmission Project team is continuing our work with landowners through the real estate acquisition process and performing the necessary studies. This includes conducting wildlife, stream and cultural surveys, along with the soil sampling needed for the design of the structure foundations.

Simultaneously, Volkert, on behalf of ATXI, is analyzing access to the right-of-way from nearby public roads at various points along the transmission corridor. The determined access points will be utilized by our crews once construction begins.

This important data collection phase allows the field crews, made up of scientists and engineers, to plan and design the 96-mile line in coordination with landowners and the community. A special "thank you" to all landowners for your collaboration with the project team and contractors during the real estate and pre-construction milestones of the project.
