Mobilizing Vegetation Management and Setting Structures

The Mark Twain Transmission Project team is now mobilizing our vegetation management contractors to assess and plan for the right of way tree clearing to begin on November 1st. Our designated vegetation contract partner, Asplundh Brush Control (ABC), is reviewing the transmission corridor and surrounding access areas to protect the future safety and reliability of the line.

Although you may see ABC crews mobilizing in the project area, the vegetation management crews will start to clear the transmission corridor and along access points in November. Common work in this process includes mowing, removal of vegetation, and application of environmentally-friendly herbicides. These practices are necessary to comply with national and state energy reliability standards.

Along with vegetation management, our construction crews continue to install foundations, create access points along the entire route and are now setting structures along portions of the right of way in Marion County. The steel monopoles are assembled in pieces at the foundation sites. Please be aware of large trucks hauling the portions of the structures in the active project area.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation during this busy construction season, so please contact us with questions or concerns.
