## Zachary Substation Construction Update

This month, our Mark Twain Transmission Project Team is continuing construction at the Zachary Substation to meet the region's energy demand and expand the system's ability to handle more energy from various points of generation, including wind. One purpose of a substation like Zachary is to change voltage from generation sources and send the energy to communities through local distribution lines. By increasing electric capacity, communities benefit from improved reliability and reduced risk of outages.

Currently, our contract partners McGrath & Associates and Sachs Electric are pouring the foundations and installing the below-grade electrical equipment. We anticipate the

Zachary Substation to be complete in the spring of 2019.

L. Keeley Construction will continue with access and line construction along the transmission corridor throughout this summer, so please maintain a safe distance from all equipment and work sites. Safety for you and work crews remains our top priority.

We will continue to make efforts to minimize disruptions and impacts for the communities during this busy phase of the project. Please contact us if you have any concerns or questions.
